Greetings in the name of Christ,

Enclosed is information about the upcoming Men's Christian Retreat to be held on February 21-23, 2020 at the Mt. Morris Camp and Conference Center, Wautoma, Wisconsin. The retreat is sponsored by the Men's Fellowship of the Lake Mills Moravian Church. The Rt. Rev. Paul A. Graf, will be out program leader. The Theme will be **"The Acquired Art of Listening Biblical Style."** Paul would like to challenge us to work at listening to God and to others. He shares this with us: Matthew 17:5 states, While he was still speaking, a bright cloud over shadowed them, and behold a voice out of the cloud said, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him! Later James would write, "You must understand this is my beloved, let everyone be quick to listen, slow to speak, slow to anger." From the moment we are born, our listening capabilities diminish so that in adulthood, viewing our cultural, societal, religious/spiritual, landscape, there is little effective listening. Claiming God as our Creator and Redeemer we are to be listening to God. But how can we be listening to God when we are not listening to one another? The message of hope is that we all can become better listeners if we take the time to train/retrain ourselves for active listening. This will be the goal for the weekend, learning to listen to one another, adopting a Biblical style of listening, hearing what our Lord Jesus is saying, inviting us be doers of the Word, "Go and do likewise."
